- Arena:** Sports complex in Petřvald-Březiny: Okrajová 1872
GPS: 49.8403N, 18.3985E
- Parking:** On the adjacent grass field (GPS: 49.84067N, 18.40026E) according to the instructions of the organizers, parking fee 50 CZK/car for two days.

To arrive at the parking lot use *Rychvaldská* street. The street named *2. května* is reserved for departure.




- Event office:** In the arena, open 10:00-11:00 AM. If you have paid properly and do not want to change or borrow an SI-card, you do not need to visit the event office.
- Punching:** SportIdent – all controls will use the AIR+ mode which allows punching up to approx. 0.5 m. Competitors must punch at the finish line (finish control also in AIR+ mode).
Backup punching in case of SportIdent failure – stamp your map using needle punches.
All competitors are obliged to have their SI-cards read out, including those who do not finish the race.
- Embargoed area:** Forest area between Rychvald and Petřvald, Ostrava-Radvanice and Ostrava-Michálkovice.

- Map:** Eldorado, SRA 4, 1:10 000, contour interval 5 m, ISOM 2017-2, printed on Pretex – water-resistant paper (Nord Service), author: Tomáš Vavřík, April 2024.

Maps will be collected at the finish line. They will be handed out after the last competitor starts (to be specified by the commentator).

- Special symbols:** 115 – brown triangle – platform
 530 – black circle – methane vent ([example](#))
 513 – black x – wooden construction
 Rootstocks are not mapped.
- Restricted areas:** It is forbidden to cross the following symbols:
 301 – Uncrossable body of water
 518 – Impassable fence
 520 – Area that shall not be entered
 521 – Building
 709 – Out-of-bounds area
 It is **permitted** to cross the symbol 509 – Railway.
- Dangerous areas:** There are some badly visible ruined fences mapped by symbol 517. They will be highlighted by black-yellow ribbons. It is **permitted** to cross them. Be careful!
- Terrain:** Slightly undulating at an altitude of 240-280m. The terrain is indented with a number of branching marshy re-entrants (sometimes also bodies of water), in some areas old slag heaps with steep slopes and remnants of mine railways. Predominantly deciduous vegetation, young beech trees sometimes reduce visibility. Occasional undergrowth of varying height and runnability, moderately dense network of paths.

- Classes:** M21E, W21E
 There are no age restrictions. The event is open to all participants from non-suspended member federations of the IOF. Women can compete in the men's category.
- New entries at the arena:** Last-minute entries have to be approved by the organizers. Last-minute entries are allowed only for classes of the public race, which runs concurrently.
- Control descriptions:** On the map and also available in the starting corridor (incl. tape, highlighters, scissors).
- Control descriptions size:** M21E: 20 x 5 cm
 W21E: 17 x 5 cm

- Training map:** Available on Saturday, self-service at the north exit of the sports complex. Unclaimed maps will also be available on Sunday.
- Start:** 00 = 12:00, intervals according to the start list.
 There are two start areas. WRE classes use the S1 start.

- Bibs:** On Sunday, all competitors are required to run with bib numbers visibly attached to their chest. Please collect your bib in the pre-start area.
- GPS tracking:** Selected competitors will run with GPS units. A list of these competitors will be published at the competition website, in ORIS and Eventor. GPS units and elastic harnesses will be distributed near the start.

- Compulsory routes:** start – map start (red ribbons)  
last control – finish (corridor)
- Line intersections:** In some classes, course lines intersect near control points. Pay attention to the control serial numbers.



- Refreshment points:** Water before start, bottled water at the finish, refreshment points at control sites.
- Snacks at the arena:** Snack bar (sweet pastry, spreads, beer, soft drinks, soups, goulash, sausage etc.). Your own cups are welcome.
- Training:** No training opportunities will be provided by the organizer. Visit the [Czech orienteering map archive](#) to find suitable areas for your individual training and contact the map owner.
- Accommodation:** The organizers provide hard floor accommodation from Saturday to Sunday with your own sleeping bags and mats in the gymnasium of the Petřvald Primary School ([map](#)) for a fee 100 CZK per person. To enter the gymnasium, you need to have a ticket which you can get at the event office on Saturday 13th April from 4 PM. You can also make additional reservations there. Parking near the school is forbidden by local authorities. You can leave your car in the arena or near the football stadium ([map](#)). Overnight stay in event arena is not permitted!
- Expected winning times:** 35 minutes
- Time limit:** 90 minutes
- Finish closing time:** The finish will be closed 90 minutes after the starting time of the last competitor.
- Time measurement:** Time is measured to the nearest whole second.
- Results:** Preliminary results will be available in the arena and on-line on OResults. Official results will be published in ORIS and Eventor.
- Prize-giving ceremony:** The prize-giving ceremony shall take place after the competition. Three best competitors will receive prizes.
- Regulations:** Participants compete at their own risk. Competitions are held in accordance with the current Orienteering Rules, Competition Regulations of Orienteering Competitions for the year 2024 and Implementing Regulations for Competitions of the Orienteering Competitions for the year 2024.
- Complaints and protests:** According to Rules for IOF World Ranking Events. Complaints can be made in the event office.

- Daycare for children:** Will not be provided.
- Toilets:** Portable toilets at the arena and on the way to the start.
- Washing up:** Plastic washing-up bowls at the arena.
- First Aid:** Basic medical treatment will be provided at the finish line.
- Rubbish:** Please, separate your rubbish!

- Warning:** Sales and promotional activities are only permitted with the approval of the event director.
- Personal data protection:** By registering for this race, each participant agrees to the publication of their personal data in the valid format of the Czech Orienteering Federation (ČSOS), including the application, start list, and results in the ORIS system, Eventor and on the competition website. Participants running with a GPS unit also consent to the recording and publication of their route.
- Photography:** Throughout the event, journalistic photos will be taken for the purpose of informing the public about the competition, settling subsidies for the event, etc., in accordance with §89 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code. Additionally, photos for the personal needs of the participants may be taken (as a memory of the competition, for the promotion of your o-club), especially during the announcement of results and the finish at the finish line.

**Transportation and  
Travel distances:**

It is suggested that competitors use their own cars. The organizer is not providing any official transportation.

The event center (Petřvald) is 10 km from the city centre (Ostrava)

Airport Ostrava (OSR) – Petřvald: 30 km, 0:30 h by car

Airport Praha (PRG) – Petřvald 400 km, 4:00 h by car

Airport Krakow (KRK) – Petřvald 150 km 1:40 h by car

Airport Katowice (KTW) – Petřvald 110 km 1:20 h by car

Airport Brno (BRQ) – Petřvald 170 km 1:40 h by car, 3:00 h by train

Airport Wien (VIE) – Petřvald 320 km 3:20 h by car, 4:30 h by train

It is possible to get to the arena by public transport from Ostrava.
