At least 3 competitors must start in the class to be awarded the master's title. In case of a small number of registered, there is a possibility of merging some categories. A picture track will be prepared for the youngest children directly at the Event centre.
Map holders	Possibility to rent at the presentation for a 2€ fee.
Starting numbers	Each competitor will receive a start number at the presentation. All competitors are obliged to place the number visibly on the bike before the start. It will not be possible to start without the start number. The start numbers are the same for Saturday and Sunday. Please return unused start numbers to the presentation. The MW10 and OPEN / OPEN E-bike categories also have start numbers.
Start 00	28.5.2022 (Saturday) At 13:00. Interval start according to the start list. Saturday (MW10) – free start between 15:00-16.00, the route to the map start will be marked with red-and-white ribbons. The race route will not be marked. Start and finish is at the kindergarten at the Event centre. Possible for parents to accompany the child. 29.5.2022 (Sunday) At 9:30. Interval start according to the start list. Sunday (MW10) – free start between 12:30 -13.30, the route to the map start will be marked with red-and-white ribbons. The race route will not be marked. Start and finish is at the kindergarten at the Event centre. Possible for parents to accompany the child.
Terrain	Mostly flat, in places passages with short steep exits and descents, sandy ground, dense network of roads and sidewalks. Forest work was taking place in the forest, which could have changed the passability on some sections of the roads. This change may not have been captured on the map.

Maps will be collected in the finish until the start of the last competitor.

Punching system

SportIdent, contactless system AIR+ will be used (allows embossing to a distance of 150-200 cm). Stamping will be possible only using SIAC, the controls do not have a hole. For competitors who do not own a SIAC, the renting will be possible (SI rental: $2 \in / day$, in case of damage or non-return: $70 \in$)

The only exception will be the MW10 category, where the standard controls will be used, so it will be possible to use standard SI as well.

The competitor is obliged to reset and check the SI (Clear + Check) before the start. In case of a failure of the SportIdent electronic punching system, the competitor punches the control with pliers in one of the reserve squares on the map. He/She is obliged to report this fact at the Read out at the Event centre.

There will be no control in the finish, but a passage through the finish carpet with a timer. Please do not stay near the carpet. The children's category MW10 punches the finish control manually.

MW10 does not have collective control for either MIDDLE or LONG - from the last control the children go directly to a separate finish.

Don't forget to have your SI read out when you arrive at the Event centre - do so as soon as possible so that we have current results. Competitors who did not finish the race and eventually did not cross the finish line are also obliged to read out the SI.

Return the borrowed SI to the organizers immediately after reading out on the last day of competition

Technical control

All competitors without exception are required to wear a properly fastened helmet on their head while moving on the track. A competitor without a helmet will not be allowed to start.

The minimum width of the tires is 1.5".


Special map marks

It is strictly prohibited to move (by bike or on foot) outside the roads marked on the map. Exceptions are grassy strips marked with orange (map mark No.824 "Open land" and No.827-830 "Crossroads or terrain route"), where the movement is allowed.





There are forbidden areas, which are marked on the map. It is not allowed to cross them (by bike or on foot). This also applies to roads leading through these forbidden areas.



Forbidden area

Is marked on the map

- By red hatching in case of forbidden area,
- Red zigzag line in case of forbidden road
- No off-road movement the competitor must use only the road when completing the course, he/she must not move on a bicycle or on feet in open terrain.

Prize-giving ceremony	Will be held after the race – on Saturday at app. 16:30, on Sunday at app. 14:30.		
Complaints	They are submitted to the Referee in writing for a deposit of € 10 and no later than one hour after the scheduled finish. The Chief Judge will then form a three-member Jury from those present at the race and submit a protest to the hearing. The decision of the Jury is final.		
Nursery	At the Event center; a picture track will also be available		
Catering	Aone regeneration drink at the finish. At the Event centre there will be a refreshment stand, there is also The Tropic Restaurant nearby which offers a menu.

	All starting cyclists must wear a bicycle helmet.		

	 The race takes place in areas where tourists and occasionally cars move (garden settlement). It is necessary to pay increased attention and caution when driving. Avoid the others by riding at the right! In the race area, competitors cross a large number of rectangular crossroads, where it is not possible to distinguish driving preference - be considerate, careful, cautions and foresighted! The race area is part of the Záhorie Protected Landscape Area. Please do not enter the restricted areas marked on the map. Violation is punishable by disqualification! Any violation of the rules, especially off-road driving (except for dark orange areas) is punishable by disqualification! Drive on the righ side of the roads. When driving uphill, the downhill racer has priority Unregistered young people under the age of 18 must present parental consent at the time of presentation.
