There will be no printed copy of bulletin 2, start lists or accommodation vouchers - everything is available on the event website and in the information systems (ORIS and IOF EVENTOR) and will be posted on the notice board in the event centre.

Only proof of payment and borrowed SI cards will be given. If you have payments in order, you are don't have to go to the registration.

Arrival and parking:

According to the attached map. Access only in the direction from Rusava.

Parking for cars will be organized in the recreation area on the local road. Please follow the instructions of the organizer who will guide you to the parking space. Passengers will be able to get off at a stop approx. 250 m from the event centre and the driver will then park (max. distance can be up to 1600 m from the event centre). Do not park without the assistance of the organizer. Do not park in places that are not intended for this (entrances to cottages, turns, etc.). A parking fee of CZK 80 will be collected on site (please have it ready accurately).

Start:

Interval start 00 = 12:00

There is one common start for all classes, but there are separate starting corridors where competitors enter at time -3min:

- left corridor classes: D16AB-D21AB, H16AB-H21AB, W21E, M21E, H35B-H50B
- right corridor classes: DH10C, DH12C, DH14B, D65B-D75B, H65B-H80B, P

There are no toilets on the way to the start.

The bags will be on the start for putting off clothes, delivery back to finish after start closing.

Starting procedure:

time -3 min - enter to the corridor, checking of names and SI cards, SI clear

time -2 min – SI check, control descriptions

time -1 min - SIAC test

starting time – taking of the map behind the starting line, mandatory section to the starting point

Adhesive tapes and highlighters will be prepared in the corridors for any modification of control descriptions.

Facilities for competitors:

In the event centre there is enough space for the club tents on the meadow. Please respect the spaces defined by the organizers and keep the min. 10 m distance from the finish corridor.

If interested, it is also possible to spend the night in tents on the meadow (no fire).

We ask competitors not to change their clothes on the buffet benches and to leave these areas free for customers of our buffet.

Terrain description:

Hilly, moderately rugged terrain with variable forest character. Tall beech forest, coniferous thickets and mixed young forest without significant boundaries. Even in a clean forest, often fallen branches, sometimes a difficult stony ground. Occasional rocks, boulders, stones, springs and clearings. Mostly good visibility and medium traffic density. In recent months, the occurrence of bark beetles and fresh clearings in places.

Rybárka – scale 1:15.000, contour interval 5 m, state 8/2022, ISOM 2017-2, format A3, for classes DH16AB-DH21ABC, WM21E

Maps will be waterproof, laser print on polysynthetic paper Pretex.

The last update took place 5 days before the race. There is limited local extraction of bark beetle trees in the competition area and new open areas can be created and the clearings can be enlarged. Root stocks are not mapped.

The maps will be collected at the finish and will be given back to the heads of each club after the start of the last competitor from 15:20.

Special map symbols:

brown triangle - platform

black cross - artificial object (fallen seating, shelter, benches etc.)

black circle - fireplace

Training map:

A small training map can be used on the way to the start. Collection of training maps is on the way to the start (approx. after 400 m, at the GPS point). Please put used maps in the trash can at the start.

Control descriptions:

For all classes to be collected at the start (in the second corridor) and on the maps.

Size of control descriptions:

 $M21E - 18 \times 5.2 \text{ cm}$ $W21E - 15 \times 5.2 \text{ cm}$

Time limit:

180 min.

Finish closure:

18:00

Punching system:

Sportident electronic system. SI cards of all generations can be used. One SI card may not be reused in a race. At the race, all controls, including the finish units, will be set to BEACON contactless mode.

Before the start, the competitors are obliged to clear and check their SI card. In the case of failure of the SI unit, competitors are obliged to punch anywhere to the map and to notify the organizer at the finish. After crossing of the finish line, it is obligatory to read out the SI card by the organizers as soon as possible, even if the competitor does not finish the race.

Courses:

For courses parameters – see the table at the end of the bulletin 2.

Please note that there are a large number of controls in the forest, which can be close to each other and the courses cross several times. Check your codes and be careful of the correct controls order.

Estimated winning times:

The M21E and W21E classes have times for long distance according to the IOF WRE Rules:

M21E 90-100 min. W21E 70-80 min.

Other classes according to the Competition Rules of Czech Orienteering Federation.

Start bibs:

All DH16A-DH20A and WM21E competitors are running with start bibs.

Competitors will take their bibs by themselves at the pre-start according to the displayed start lists and are obliged to attach the bib visibly to their chest (no folding).

After the finish it is mandatory to return the bibs back to the organizer.

GPS:

Selected competitors of the following categories will run with GPS units:

W21E, M21E, D20A, H20A, D18A, H18A

The list of selected competitors will be published separately on the event website and in the event centre.

Competitors pick up vests and GPS units in a special tent about halfway to the start.

You can also use your own vest or your club vest.

According to the Rules the selected competitors are obliged to carry the assigned GPS units during the race.

Clothing restriction:

There are no shoes or clothing restriction.

The organizers definitely recommend shoes with studs, complete covering of the legs and taping of the ankles.

Refreshment:

Drinking water available during the race.

On the long distance, refreshment points are located both among controls and on the control.

Water with syrup at the finish.

Competition area:

All forest areas south from the main road from Rusava and along the road to the start are competition areas with no entry, even for spectators. The exception is the training map area. It is forbidden to leave the area of the training map to the neighboring forbidden area.

It is prohibited to enter fenced areas.

Mandatory sections:

Will be marked with red stripes or a marked corridor:

- start start of orientation
- last control finish

The competitors run from the last control across the road and across the stream to the finish field. The crossing of the road will be organized and guarded by the organizers, however, we ask for caution. Rusava is a popular tourist destination, and especially when the weather is nice there is an increased movement of local cottagers, mushroom pickers and cyclists on the weekend.








Map of arrival and parking:
