Punching system: SPORTIdent – controls will be in contactless mode (AIR+)

Competitors must punch control at the finish line

Reserve punching in case of SI failure - manualy to the map.

All competitors must do SI card readout, including competitors who haven't finished

the race.

Estimated winning times: 35 minutes.

Regulation: Participants compete at their own risk.

Breakfast: At the accommodation site (ZŠ Petřvald) pre-ordered breakfasts will be available for

pickup. Brakfast orders can be placed through the Eventor (services).

Menu and price will be published on competition website later.

Refreshment: water will be available before start, on certain control point and in the finish

Notice: Any sales and promotional activities are allowed only with the consent of the event

director

Additional programme: There will be Czech Championships in night orienteering on Saturday 13th April which

is completely open for anyone - website - entries

Personal data protection: By registering for this race, each participant agrees to the publication of their personal

data in the valid format of the Czech Orienteering Federation (ČSOS), including the application, start list, and results in the ORIS system, Eventor and on the race website. Participants running with a GPS unit also consent to the recording and

publication of their route.

Photography: Throughout the event, journalistic photos will be taken for the purpose of informing the

public about the competition, settling subsidies for the event, etc., in accordance with §89 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code. Additionally, photos for the personal needs of the participants may be taken (as a memory of the competition, for the

o-club), especially during the announcement of results and the finish at the finish line. In case you do not agree with being photographed, please explicitly notify the
