Event centre

Jestřebí, we recommend that you have club tents.

Travel directions

Event centre: meadow at GPS: 50°37'2.403"N, 14°32'35.334"E

turn left from route **no.9** Mělník - Česka Lípa 3 km beyond Jestřebí village (in a small wood) onto a small narrow road (direction Šváby) and after 200 m turn left again onto the meadow. Will be signposted.

Parking

A private meadow in the event centre. Follow the organisers' instructions, please..

Registration

Friday: 15 Apr 9:30 – 11:30 in the event centre (entries for T, P, HDR and HD10L and changes to entries throughout all days). **Please check your payments at:** http://oris.orientacnisporty.cz/PrehledVkladu?id=6759. If the payments on the web do not agree with those that you sent, please contact pe2022@obkotlarka.cz, or bring a payment receipt/confirmation. **Only whole clubs can be registered (not selected groups of people)!!!** Clubs without outstanding debts will be prioritised at registration.

If there are changes to your SI card numbers or other changes, send them by email to pe2022@obkotlarka.cz in advance. You will save us and yourself time. We will be able to receive the emails right until the event.

Training

Training maps will be sold on Thurs 14 Apr in the gym (sports hall) of the school in Dubá (entrance from the yard) (50.5406347N, 14.5390225E) from 13:00-14:00 – will be signposted. Training map cost 50 CZK (2 EUR).

Terén

Very rugged, rocky ridges and valleys, rocks on several levels (sandstone), mostly runnable forest, areas with scrubby vegetation, many tracks.

Maps

- **Stage 2:** PAVLOVICKÝ DŮL 2022, 1 : 10 000, A3 size, for classes DH16, DH18, DH20 a DH21EAB, H35A, H40A **from start S1**,

- DRCHLAVSKÁ ROKLE, 1:7500, A3 size, for classes D35A, D40A, D45A, H35B, H45A, H50A, H55A **from start S1**,
- ŠVÁBY, 1: 7500, A4 size, for classes HDR, DH10F, DH10, DH12, DH14, D35B, D40B, D45B, D50, D55, D60, D65, D70, D75, H45B, H50B, H55,B, H60, H65, H70, H75, H80, H85, T3, T4, T6, B3, B5, P **from start S2**, all E = 5m, R. Ondráček 2018, updated autumn 2021 winter 2022.
- **Stage 3.:** POPELOV, 1: 10 000, A3 size, for classes H16, DH18, DH20, DH21EAB, H35AB, H40A, H45A, H50A, T6
- PANSKÝ HÁJ 2022 1 : 7 500, A4 size, for all other classes, both E = 5m, mapped autumn 2017, R. Horký, R. Ondráček, updated autumn 2021 winter 2022.
- Maps for all stages are printed on waterproof paper.

Forbidden areas

- **Purple diagonal intersecting lines** (map symbol 709) indicate forbidden areas due to vegetation protection (**newly planted clearings**) not necessarily marked on the ground.
- It is forbidden to enter settlements (map symbol 520).

Special instructions and symbols

- It is permitted to enter **the orchard area** (map symbol 413) anywhere with a ruined fence (map symbol 517). Anywhere with a high fence, (map symbol 518) the orchard must only be entered at the marked crossing point (map symbol 710).
- In Stage 2, a special symbol (modified map symbol 710) is used at the point where there is a steep slope. A **ladder** is installed here, which **allows the steep slope to be crossed in the direction of the passage**, but does not allow the slope to be crossed into the side valley.

Start numbers

Start numbers are mandatory for all competitors and will be available in the club envelopes at registration. T and P categories do not have start numbers.

Each competitor must write their Stage 3 start time according to the start list onto their start number - use a permanent marker, available at the Stage 3 event centre or at the start. Start numbers will be available at the Stage 3 start for the top five competitors after two stages in classes B3, B5, DH10F, DH10, DH12, DH14, DH16, DH18, DH20, DH21E, DH35A, DH40A, DH45A, D50, H50A, DH55, DH60, DH65, DH70, DH75, H80 and H85. These competitors must have **both** numbers attached to their tops.

Start

- Stage 1: 00 = 12:00, distance 2100 m, 40 m climb, blue-and-white tapes,
- Stage 2: **00** = **10:00**, by bus from the event centre 8 km (12 min), then continuing on foot S1: 1700m, 35 m climb, blue-and-white tapes, classes with maps PAVLOVICKÝ DŮL 2022 or DRCHLAVSKÁ ROKLE

S2: 600 m, 0 m climb, green-and-white tapes, classes with map ŠVÁBY

• Stage 3: 00 = 10:00, distance 1700m, 10 m climb, blue-and-white tapes.

Classes T, P and HDR start at any time in a separate start corridor with a punching start, up to a maximum start time of 180.

Bus transport st Stage 2

The first bus leaves from Zahrádky-Borek 50.6192883N, 14.5415425E at 9:00, then subsequent buses every five minutes. At the bus drop-off point, you will be able to leave your clothes in your own bag labelled with your start number (clothes area will be supervised). After the race, you will collect your clothes here and return by bus. **Do not drive your own cars to the bus drop-off point, there is no parking space.**

The chasing start lasts 30 minutes in each class. Competitors with a loss greater than 30 minutes on the class leader after two stages will then start at regular one-minute intervals. The P, T3, T6 and HDR classes do not have a chansing start. These classes start at any time until the start of the last competitor in the other classes.

Entry to the star corridor of Stage 3 is 6 minutes before the actual start time!

The Stage 3 start list will be available in the event centre on Sunday morning, in the sports hall and available on the event website (http://obkotlarka.cz/zavody/pe2022) on Saturday evening.

Punching system

Sportident electronic punching system. All types of SI cards including SI10 and SI11 can be used for the race. The SportIdent units at controls, including the finish, will be set to the BEACON contactless punching mode (allowing punching up to 0.5 m).

At the start, the competitor must clear his/her chip in the first box and then perform a check in the second box.

Finish

Stage 1, Stage 3: in the event centre,

Stage 2: 700 m, 45 m climb to the bus pick-up point. SI download in the event centre.

Arrangements at the finish

Stage 1, Stage 2: the competitor records his/her finish time by punching the finish unit.

Stage 3: The competitors punch the finish unit just after the finishing line. The order at the finish line is decisive (as determined by the referee). For competitors outside the chasing start, the control unit after the finish line is the finish unit, as in the first two stages.

After punching the finish unit, the competitor must not return into the competition area. Competitors who have hired an SI card from the organiser should return it after completing their last stage at SI download. Even those who did not finish the race for any race must report at the event centre and download their SI card.

Control descriptions

Control descriptions for each class will be available in the event centre. There are no control descriptions at the start or on the maps!

Courses

- E1: classic distance
- E2: shortened distance
- E3: classic distance

Time limit

- Stage 2: 120 minut
- Stage 1, Stage 3: 160 minut

Refreshments

Drinking water at the Stage 1 and Stage 3 starts and at start S1 of Stage 2. On the longer courses for Stage 1 and Stage 3. Squash available at the finish of all stages.

In the event centre there are traders with refreshments as well as the popular Kafeterie.

WC

Toi Toi portable toilets only in the event centre, there are none on the way to the start or at the bus drop-off point! If you don't manage on the way to the start, please relieve yourself away from the built-up area.

Washing

In the event centre, there will be a cistern with water and washbasins available. We ask competitors to conserve water. **The water is drinking water.**

Crèche

There will be a crèche for young children at the event centre of all three stages. Please leave your children in the crèche only for as long as necessary (your race time).

Important information: During Stage 2 it is possible that the parent would not be able to make their start time after completing the HDR class with their child (bus ride to the event centre and then bus to the start). In that case, the child can be "droped off" at the bus point with the organizer, who will deliver children to the event centre at regular intervals. Here they can be picked up at the crèche. There is also a pub and playground in the village.
